



"Crossboundaries Kids" - the project is based on the concept of design thinking. We would like to share the skill of design thinking to the next generation. Our vision now is that design is not only an industry but also a way of thinking. We believe it has been underestimated and undervalued. We think the skill of design thinking is one creative tool kit to get us on track to survive in the 21st century. Perfectly, the traditional architectural training provides such a methodology.

We already reached about 200 students from elementary school and middle school, and we would like to expand the amount to 2,500 for offline program, and 100,000 for online program.

Megacities are drowning in trash all over the world. Single-use plastics, such as bottle caps and cigarette filters are washed into the oceans and pose a threat to marine ecosystems. The goal of Cleanr is to remove plastic litter before it reaches the ocean by intercepting it where it originates and to improve livability in the city.

> We are expecting to have a steep learning and expansion curve starting from the current pilot with city cleaning services in Germany's capital city Berlin, and to be present in 500 megacities by 2025.
